Description of the award:

This category seeks to recognise a practice or group of practices who have developed new collaborative working with patients and other organisations, to improve care or introduce new services. We invite applications from both practices themselves and nominations from others.

Applications should demonstrate all or some of the below:

- A clear description of the changes made to the way care is delivered, and the way in which collaborative working with patients and/or other providers of health and care has been involved. The changes may be an improvement to an existing service or the introduction of a new service.
- Evidence of the impact for patients and staff, including improvements in patient experience, staff morale, access, clinical outcomes or practice resilience.
- A clear rationale behind the selection of this particular area of activity for improvement.

Criteria that judges will be marking against:

- Clear evidence of the impact of the changes on the way care is delivered.
- Evidence that the change has had benefits for patients, staff or practices.
- The sustainability of the changes made.
